Possible resources include the scriptures, <i>Handbook 2: Administering the Church</i> (08702), Church magazines, <i>Daughters in My Kingdom: The History and Work of Relief Society</i> (06500), <i>Family Guidebook</i> (31180), and other Church-approved resources.</p> <p>SECOND AND THIRD SUNDAYS Members study, discuss, and apply general conference messages from the First Presidency, Quorum of the Twelve Apostles, and other Church leaders, using suggestions in <i>Come, Follow Me—For Melchizedek Priesthood and Relief Society</i> (Ensign or Liahona, Nov. 2017, 137–44, or ComeFollowMe.Lds.org).</p> <p>If the general conference messages are not available in your language, either in the November 2017 <i>Ensign</i> or <i>Liahona</i> or on LDS.org, use <i>Duties and Blessings of the Priesthood, Part B</i> (31112) or <i>The Latter-day Saint Woman, Part B</i> (31114).</p> <p>FOURTH SUNDAY Members study a doctrinal topic related to the work of the Melchizedek Priesthood and Relief Society, using suggestions in <i>Come, Follow Me—For Melchizedek Priesthood and Relief Society</i> (Ensign or Liahona, Nov. 2017, 137–44, or ComeFollowMe.Lds.org).</p> <p>If <i>Come, Follow Me—For Melchizedek Priesthood and Relief Society</i> is not available in your language, the First Presidency Messages and Visiting Teaching Messages may be used.</p> <p>FIFTH SUNDAY Bishoprics or branch presidencies plan the meeting.</p>
