Children and Youth Emblems

On November 17, 2019, The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints announced Children and Youth emblems of belonging and emblems of achievement. See <u>childrenandyouth.Church</u> of Jesus Christ.org for more information. Wards and branches are responsible for placing orders for these emblems.

Wards and branches implementing the program on January 1, 2020, should order emblems of belonging and achievement between now and February 29, 2020. These wards and branches are those with members who speak ASL, Cantonese, Cebuano, English, French, German, Hiligaynon, Ilokano, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Mandarin, Portuguese, Russian, Samoan, Spanish, Tagalog, and Tongan.

Wards and branches in units implementing the program on March 1, 2020, should order emblems between March 1, 2020, and May 31, 2020. These wards and branches are those with members who speak Albanian, Arabic, Armenian, Bislama, Bulgarian, Cambodian, Croatian, Czech, Danish, Dutch, Estonian, Fijian, Finnish, Greek, Haitian, Hungarian, Indonesian, Kekchi, Kiribati, Latvian, Lithuanian, Malagasy, Malay, Marshallese, Mongolian, Norwegian, Polish, Romanian, Swahili, Swedish, Tahitian, Thai, Ukrainian, and Vietnamese.

The enclosed "Children and Youth Emblems: Instructions for Clerks" provides additional details. The enclosed "Resource for Ordering Children and Youth Emblems" and "Ring-Sizing Tool for Children and Youth Emblems" can also assist ward and branch clerks and officers in gathering quantities for orders.

Awards for Current Achievement Programs

As has been previously announced, those who would like to finish current achievement programs should complete the requirements before January 1, 2020. As an exception, if children or youth need additional time, the awards will be available to order until March 1, 2020.

Unfortunately, the current Young Womanhood Recognition is out of stock until February 2020. It can, however, be ordered now and shipped when possible. Please order only as many as necessary. Until the Young Womanhood Recognition is again in stock, please check in supply closets, in clerks' offices, and with neighboring wards for any extras. Many units may have some available.

Children and Youth Emblems: Instructions for Clerks

Enclosure to the December 23, 2019, notice "Instructions for Ordering Children and Youth Emblems"

Clerks should order all Children and Youth emblems of belonging and achievement for 2020 through a single order at <u>store.ChurchofJesusChrist.org/childrenandyouth</u> or through their local distribution retail store. Emblems of belonging for implementation in 2020 will not be charged to units. Costs for the emblem of achievement will be charged to units.

Wards and branches implementing the program on January 1, 2020, should order emblems of belonging and achievement between now and February 29, 2020. Wards and branches in units implementing the program on March 1, 2020, should order emblems between March 1, 2020, and May 31, 2020. Shipment of emblems of belonging will begin about March 2020 and continue for several months. Shipment of the Children and Youth crystal (emblem of achievement) will begin about April 2020.

Emblems of Belonging

Units should order emblems of belonging for active children and youth as follows.

- Children turning 8–11 in 2020: Children and Youth ring for children and a picture of the temple in the ward or branch's assigned temple district
- Young men turning 12–18 in 2020: Children and Youth ring for young men and temple recommend holder
- Young women turning 12–18 in 2020: Children and Youth medallion for young women and temple recommend holder
- Young men turning 18 in 2020: Children and Youth oil vial for young men
- Young women turning 18 in 2020: Children and Youth pendant for young women

Units may also place orders for additional children or youth ages 8–18 in their boundaries who may benefit from receiving these emblems (units may order additional emblems in quantities up to 30 percent of the number of active children or youth). If any emblems need to be replaced, units should wait until after June 1, 2020, to order additional items.

Emblems of Achievement

Wards and branches should also order the Children and Youth crystal for all youth turning 18 in 2020 who are likely to receive the emblems of achievement as outlined at childrenandyouth.ChurchofJesusChrist.org. The First Presidency certificate (also part of the emblems of achievement) can be printed locally on quality paper through Leader and Clerk Resources (LCR) beginning about April 2020 and does not need to be ordered.


