



Driving Directions to Camp Haven via 1-15 headed South.

Take Exit 257 B-A for US 6 E toward Price

Continue onto US -6 E for 14 miles

Turn right onto US-89 S (Sign for Mt. Pleasant/ Ephraim/ Manti) travel for 18.2 miles

After you pass the road on your left that goes to the little town of Indianola...watch for milepost marker 295 on the left of the road. (The numbers will be descending as you drive south) Go exactly **0.3 miles south past the milepost marker.** You'll be looking

for the turnoff **to your right** that is marked with the *Big Horn Ranch Association and Camp Haven Signs.*



(Important: Please disregard the Google Maps suggestions that it is only 13 minutes from the highway. **This is a gravel road and driving time is more like 20-25 minutes)**

This road is called “**Lake Canyon Road- 34750 North**” Travel directly west along this gravel road for about 1 mile. When you're about to the gate the road turns 90 degrees directly north for the last little bit.

The Lower Gate is a double swing, green metal gate with a a dangling chain. If the gate is locked, you'll find the combination lock in the protected metal box in the center on the chains.

Enter the combination and push the lock and bar together in order to pop it free. If it doesn't open on the first try, start over by spinning all of the numbers to a different number.

Please make sure the gate is closed and locked after you pass unless there is traffic behind you. The **last vehicle in the group must lock the gate** as there are range cattle in the area.

Drive westward for about 4.4 miles up the winding dirt road to Camp Haven. There is another gate called the "Upper gate" which is just before the property. This "upper" gate is often left open during the busy summer months. Should the upper gate be locked for any reason, please enter the upper gate combination. Again, please remember to close the gate behind you.

It is a total of 4.4 miles from the lower gate to the Area 1 sign at the camp.

Drivers should be aware that the roads from the lower gate to Camp Haven are somewhat rocky and rough. It is recommended that an **all wheel drive vehicle be used** when driving to camp. During a rain storm the roads often become slippery. It is highly recommended to carpool as well.

The advised speed limit is 10 mph. Driving in excess of 10 mph can cause damage to the road and vehicle. Also be on the lookout for traffic coming off the mountain.
