for Treks at Mormon Handcart Historic Site 2018





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Selecting an Itinerary

This document outlines all of the itineraries offered at the Mormon Handcart Historic Site during each week of the 2018 season. Each of the itineraries is unique, and each is offered every week of the trekking season.

After selecting an itinerary that best fits the group's needs, the stake or ward can make a reservation at camping.lds.org, using the name of the itinerary as listed in this document.

Group Size

The itineraries in this document are designed for groups of up to 200 people, including all youth, adults, leaders, and support people. Groups may schedule only one itinerary each. If a stake has a group of 500 people, they would need

to be separated into three groups within the stake. A different ward could schedule each group. In the comments section of the scheduling form, the person making the reservation should note that his or her group is associated with the other wards in the group.

Please direct any questions about groups larger than 200 people or smaller than 50 people to the Mormon Handcart Historic Site before scheduling (1-307-328-2953).

Rocky Ridge

Each year the Mormon Handcart Historic Site receives a limited number of permits to cross Rocky Ridge. The maximum size of groups is 350 participants (two or more smaller groups may combine to achieve this total). Groups are allowed to cross Rocky Ridge between July 1 and September 15 each year.

Groups that want to trek over Rocky Ridge should make a reservation for one of the itineraries that lists Rocky Ridge as

a possible activity. Because of the limited number of permits, not all groups that request Rocky Ridge will be able to trek over it. Groups that have been selected will be notified.

National Historic Trail Training

For groups that will trek over Rocky Ridge, all adults (both trekking and support) are required to take National Historic Trail (NHT) training within 24 hours before crossing. The time and location for taking this 45-minute course will be determined by the group's itinerary before you cross Rocky Ridge.

Trek Leader Training

Trek leader training is required for any group with more than 25 people. Training is held in the spring and the fall of each year. Please call 1-307-328-2953 to schedule training.

Description of Activities

Martin's Cove

A visit to Martin's Cove is a quiet experience. No handcarts are allowed in the cove, although rickshaws may be used for those who are unable to walk. This activity usually has two parts: an amphitheater program and the cove walk.

Amphitheater Program

Before groups walk through Martin's Cove, they hold an amphitheater program to set the stage and to share the experiences of the Martin handcart company. Groups may designate a speaker or invite site missionaries to share stories. Two amphitheaters are available at Martin's Cove.

The lower amphitheater is for groups of fewer than 75 people, and the Dan Jones Amphitheater is for groups of any size. Only the Dan Jones Amphitheater has audio equipment (connections for MP3 players).

Cove Walk

The cove walk is a reverent, quiet walk through Martin's Cove, best conducted individually or in smaller groups, if possible. It is an opportunity to ponder what happened at Martin's Cove and to honor those who lost their lives there.

Rescue Statues

The rescue statues honor rescuers who carried many members of the Martin handcart company across the Sweetwater River to reach Martin's Cove. Some members of the Martin company also carried people across.

Veil Crossing Bridge

The Veil Crossing Bridge near Martin's Cove has two monuments—one on each side. The first monument honors the pioneers of the Martin handcart company. The second monument honors the "second rescue," in which temple ordinances were completed for the pioneers who were unable to receive these blessings for themselves.

Devil's Gate

Devil's Gate is half a mile from the Veil Crossing Bridge. This distinctive geographical feature was a landmark for all pioneers. The Martin handcart company camped in this area for two nights in a severe snowstorm before moving to Martin's Cove.

Fort Seminoe

Fort Seminoe was a trading post in the 1850s that consisted of several log buildings. The original location of the main building is visible today. Visitors can tour a reconstructed replica of the fort.

Sixth Crossing

The Sixth Crossing itinerary has two trail options: 6 miles and 10 miles. Each is a loop that begins and ends at a campground.

View Ridge

At View Ridge, visitors can see the original trail. To the east, the trail leads to where express riders found the Willie handcart company; to the west, the trail leads to the Sixth Crossing of the Sweetwater River.

Linford Monument

In 1998, descendants of John Linford, a member of the Willie company who died in this area, placed the Linford Monument near the trail to honor their ancestor and eight other people who perished at Sixth Crossing.

Men's Callout and Women's Pull

The men's callout and women's pull usually occur on a hill. The men's callout separates the young men from the young women. A priesthood leader explains that during the early days of the Church, fathers, brothers, and sons were often called to serve missions, and in the case of the handcart companies, many men died on the trail. Women often assumed heavy physical labor to ensure that their families reached Zion. During this activity, the women pull the handcarts up the hill without the men. Groups can conduct the activity at different locations.

Symbolizing the absence of the young men by calling them to serve in the Mormon Battalion is historically inaccurate and is therefore inappropriate. The march of the Mormon Battalion occurred 10 years before handcart travel began.

River Crossings

At Martin's Cove, the river crossing is a reverent reenactment of the rescuers helping members of the Martin company cross the Sweetwater River to reach the cove. Music and stories can be shared on either bank.

Treks at Sixth Crossing can have up to three river crossings. The first crossing is usually reverent, even though this Sweetwater crossing was not a rescue crossing. Music and stories can be shared on either bank. Some groups use the last crossing as a fun water playtime at the end of the trek day.

Rocky Ridge

The difficult 14.5-mile trek over Rocky Ridge begins at Sage Campground and ends at Rock Creek Hollow. The first three miles are extremely rocky and climb 600 feet. The Willie handcart company crossed Rocky Ridge during a snowstorm, and many pioneers considered this the most difficult stretch of their journey.

Because this trail is on government and private lands, participants are not permitted to step off the trail. The maximum size of a group is 350 people.

Rock Creek Hollow

Rock Creek Hollow, about 10 miles west of Rocky Ridge, includes a memorial and grave site for members of the Willie handcart company who lost their lives on this stretch of the trail.

Evening Activities

Evening activities are under the direction of ward or stake leaders. Missionaries may help as requested. Activities can include square dancing, pioneer express (delivery of letters from home), stories (for example, about Ephraim Hanks or Levi Savage), skits, plays, games, or testimony meetings, which can be done in the campground or at an amphitheater. If the group desires to square dance or needs an amphitheater, the location must be reserved by calling the site office at 1-307-328-2953.

Square dancing is not allowed at Sage Campground because of space limitations or at Rock Creek Hollow because of its reverent location.
