
# Home Centered, Seminary Supported





## **RELYING ON THE SAVIOR**

The Savior will help us accomplish this objective. All we do should help young people know and love the Savior. Students will then be able to deepen their experiences at home and in seminary.



#### STARTING SEMINARY

There is no change to when students begin attending seminary. However, new students can start reading the year's course of study beginning in January 2020. As they read the corresponding assignments in the *Come*, *Follow Me* program, students can record their progress in mySeminary. Reading in advance is not a requirement.



### READING REQUIREMENTS

Students are encouraged to read the scriptures every day. For graduation, students are expected to complete the reading assignments for each course of study. The reading assignments correspond with the *Come*, *Follow Me* program for the year. Students can record their reading assignments in mySeminary, and teachers can verify them in WISE.



#### **ASSESSMENTS**

The current learning assessments will be used until January 2022. Then the learning assessments will be revised to focus on Doctrinal Mastery passages. Students will be able to retake these assessments as many times as they want. Beginning in January 2020, informal reviews and assessments will be included throughout the curriculum. There will also be two formal assessments per year.



#### **COURSE REQUIREMENTS**

There will no longer be grades in seminary. Course completion will be awarded according to attendance, but no letter grade will be assigned.



### **GRADUATION**

Graduation from seminary will be awarded according to the course completion of eight semesters of seminary, learning assessment completion, and all reading requirements.

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
