
Moses's and Israel's Experiences with Jehovah at Mount Sinai (Exodus 19–34)



- 1 God calls Moses to deliver Israel (see Exodus 3:1–12).
- 2 God invites Israel to be His covenant people (see Exodus 19:3–7).
- Moses reports Israel's desire to enter God's covenant (see Exodus 19:8–14).
- 4 God warns that the people are not yet prepared to enter His presence (see Exodus 19:16–25).
- God speaks the Ten Commandments to the Israelites (see Exodus 20:1–20).
- 6 God gives Israel additional laws (see Exodus 20:21–24:4).

- Israel enters into the covenant (see Exodus 24:5–8).
- God writes His law on stone tables (see Exodus 24:9–31:18).
- 9 Israel breaks the covenant (see Exodus 32:1–20).
- Moses pleads for the people (see Exodus 32:30–33:7).
- God writes His law on new stone tables
 but withholds the higher priesthood and
 its ordinances (see Exodus 34:1–32; Joseph
 Smith Translation, Exodus 34:1–2; D&C
 84:25–27).
