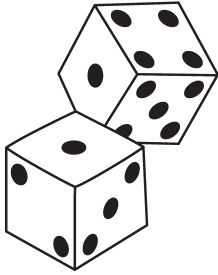


I should treat sacred things with reverence (Doctrine and Covenants 63:64).
