

Draw a Missionary

The first missionaries were called to teach people about Jesus Christ's restored Church in September 1830. Follow the guidelines below to learn how to draw a missionary from the early days of the Church.

1



With a soft pencil, sketch an egg shape for the head, a tube for the neck, and a rounded line for the shoulders.

2



Lightly draw some lines indicating where the eyes and nose go.

3



Add ovals for the eyes and curved lines for the nose, mouth, and ears. Keep shapes simple.

4



Add details like hair and clothes. Make any changes you think will make the drawing better.

5



Erase construction lines and thicken the remaining lines.

6



Use watercolor, crayons, or colored pencils to add color.
