

# The Favorite Ball

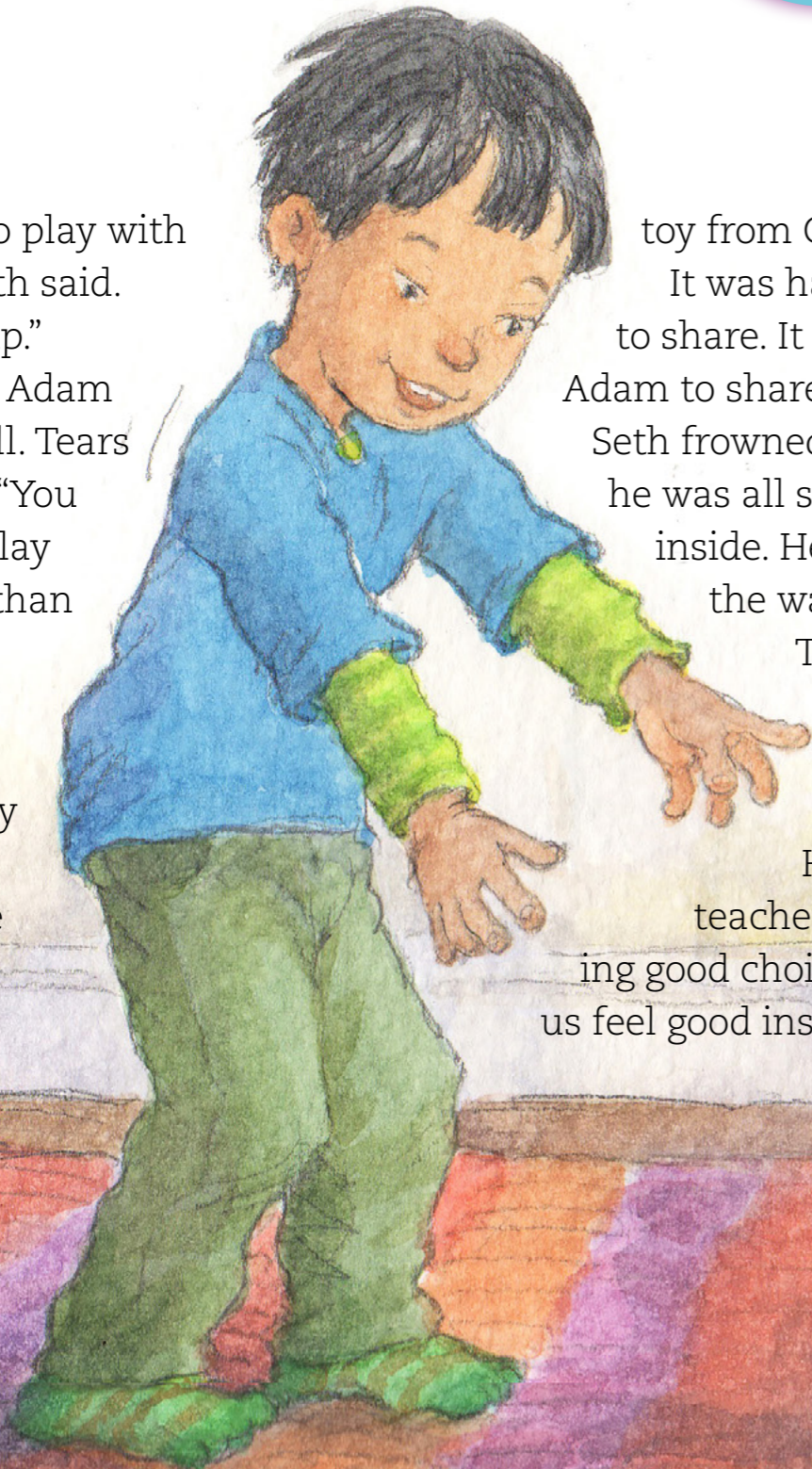

Then Seth thought about something.

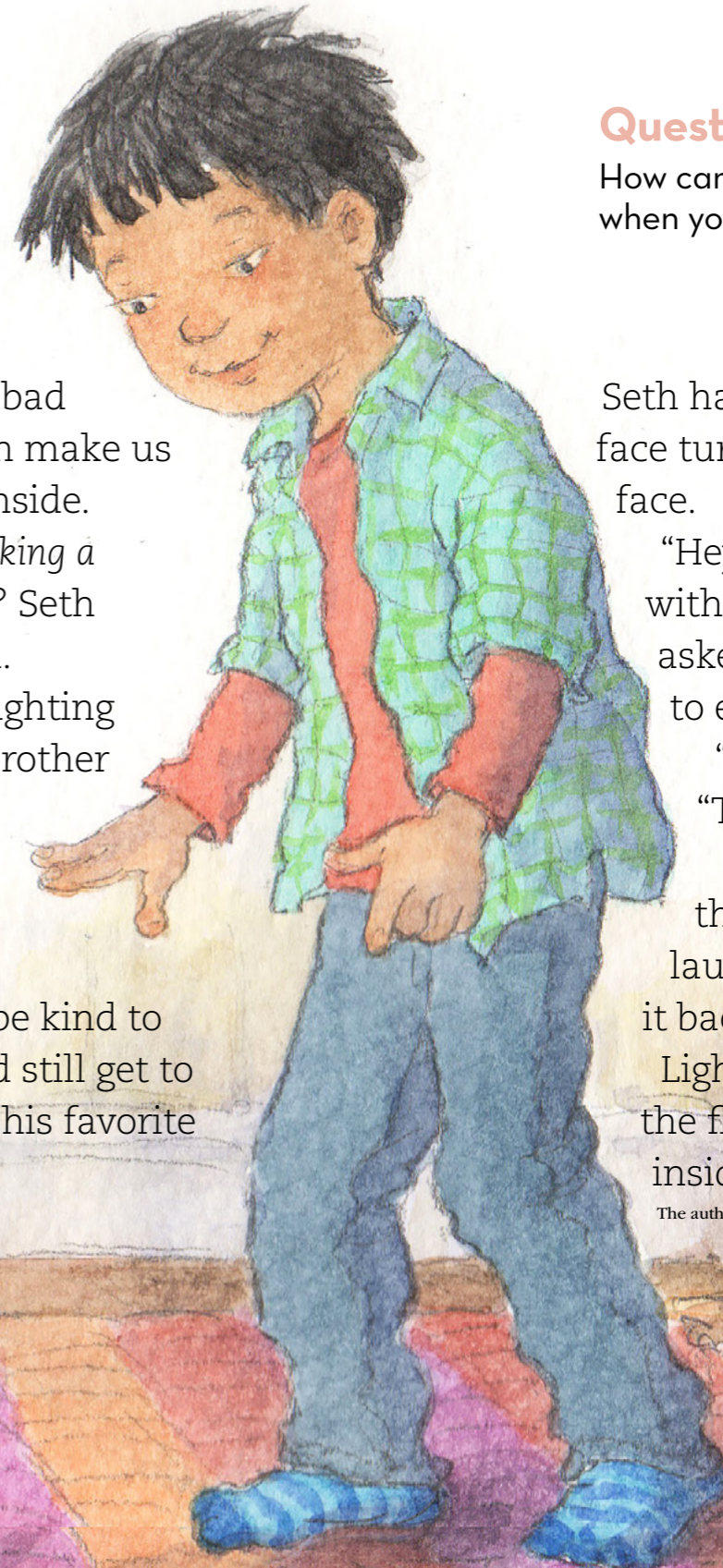
His Primary teacher said making good choices can help us feel good inside. She said
