“The earth was corrupt before God, and it was filled with violence. . . .

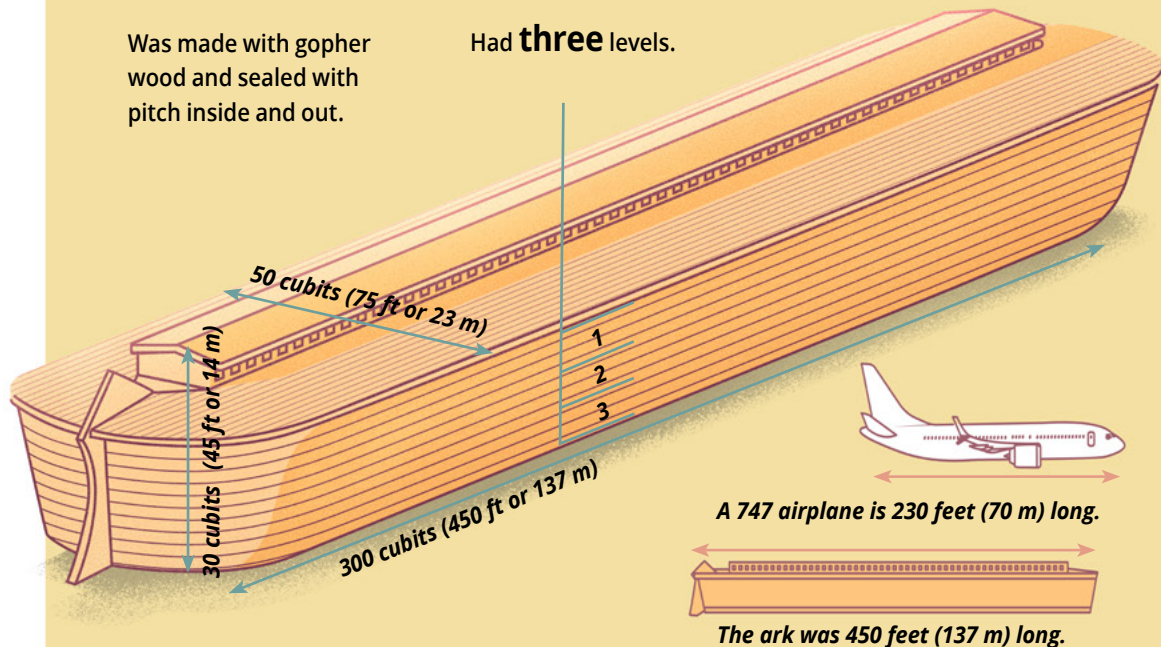
“And God said unto Noah: The end of all flesh is come before me” (Moses 8:20, 28, 30).

Despite “the longsuffering of God . . . in the days of Noah, . . . [only] eight souls were saved” (1 Peter 3:20).

THE ARK

Was made with gopher wood and sealed with pitch inside and out.


Had **three** levels.

their sons Shem, Ham, and Japheth 

and their wives 

“Clean” animals by sevens 

“Unclean” animals by twos 

(Clean and unclean animals are identified in Leviticus 11.)

DISCUSSION

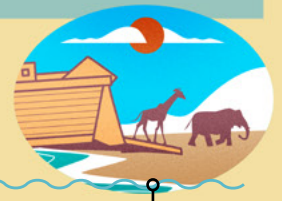
In what ways does living the gospel of Jesus Christ protect our families during times of corruption and violence—just as the ark protected Noah and his family?
