Aïnwōt ad kar kōm̄māne mōk-tal̄ok, jenaaj karoñ kom̄ ñe kālet ko emōj errā kaki ilo wāween in.



Ilo Jabōt in Ijtō in jej kamōñōñōk mākūtküt in eto ad kōttare im eai-boojoj ilo bwebwenato in laj in.

Ej raan eo me ekar uköt men otemjej.

Ilo raan ñe, mour e aō ekar oktak.
Mour eo am̄ ekar oktak.

Mejān kajjik eo an aolep ajri ro nejin Anij ekar oktak.

Ilo raan ñe ejeramqan, Rilomqor an armej otemjej, Eo ekar bōk ioon Make tomede ko an jerawiwi im mej ko rekar likwōj kōj, kar anjō jān tomede kein im kanemkwoj kōj.

Kōnke katok eo an Ripinmuur eo ad eo elap iakwe ippān, mej ejelōk an kein ire, lüb ejelōk an anjō,¹ Setan ejelōk an kajoor, im jekar “bar lotak. . . ñan juon kōjatdikdik e mour kōn jerkakpeje eo an Jisōs Kraist.”²

Em̄ool, Rijlōk Paul ekar kajimwe ke ekar ba jemaroñ “kaenōm̄an doon kōn naan kein”³

Tiriamq eo an Anij

Jemaroñ kōnono kōn Pinmuur eo an Rilomqor eo—ejimwe bwe jen kōm̄mane!

Ilo naan ko an Jekab, “Etke jab kōnono kōn pinmuur eo an Kraist, im jibadek juon jelā eo eweppān

kōn E?”⁴ Ak jej “kōnono kōn Kraist, . . . mōñōñō ilo Kraist, . . . kwałok kōn Kraist, [im] kanaan kōn Kraist”⁵ ilo iien otemjej remqan, jej aikuj jab luuji eñjake in kautiej eo ad im kam̄oolol elap kōn katok eo ejelōk jemłokin an Nejin Anij.

Pinmuur eo an Rilomqor eo ejjab ejelōk aorōkin kōnke elap kōjerbale ilo ad katakin, ad oktak, ak ilo būruwōd. Ej ittiñō im kwojarjar, bwe ekar jān “katok elap im áliktata” bwe Jisōs RiKraist eo ekar bōktok “lomqor ñan aolep ro renabaj tōmak ilo Etan.”⁶

Ikar bwilōñ im lōmñak bwe Nejin Anij enaaj kōttāeiki E ñan lōmqoren kōj, āinwōt emakijkij in ad jab wāppen, jab erreo, niknik kōm̄man bōd, im jab kam̄oolol. Ikar kajjiegoñ in mejèle Pinmuur eo an Rilomqor eo kōn lōmñak eo aō elikjab, im kōm̄lele in wōt imaroñ in wanlōñtak kake ej: Iakwe in an Anij ñan kōj emwilāl, ewāppen, im ejelōk jemłokin. Ijjab maroñ jino antqone “depakpakin, im aetokan, im mwilāl in, im utiej . . . [in] iakwe eo an Kraist.”⁷

Kadkad in iakwe in ekajoor ej ta eo jeje ko rekwojarjar ekkā an ñae etan *tiriamq an Anij*—jipañ eo ekwojarjar im menin letok an kajoor eo jej

eddōk jān ad kar armej ro remōñqo im relikjab im kiiō wanlōñlōk kōn m̄ool im meram, mae iien [jej] aiboojoj ilo m̄ool im [jelā] men otemjej.”⁸

Ej juon men ekabwilōñlōñ, tiriamqo in an Anij. Kiiō, ekkā tarpok kake.⁹ Aaet, jej aikuj jelā kōn tiriamq an Anij eñaññe jej kōnaan in dełōñe ta eo emōj kōpooje ñan kōj ilo aelōñ eo An indeeo.

Kōn unin, ikōnaan kōnono kōn tiriamq. Elaptata, juon, ewi wāween an tiriamq *kōppelqki kōjem̄ ko ilañ* im, ruo, ewi wāween *an kōppelqke wintō ko ilañ*.

Juon: Tiriamq ej Kōppelqk Kōjem̄ ko Ilañ

Kōnke kōj aolep raar “jerowiwi, im rej likjab jān aiboojoj an Anij”¹⁰ im kōnke “im ejelōk jabdewōt men ettoon emaroñ dełōñ ilo aelōñ in Anij,”¹¹ kōj kajjojo rej jab wānōk ñan rōq ñan imaan mejān Anij.

Aaet meñē jaar iten jerbal ñan Anij kōn aolepān ad, ej jab bwe, bwe jenaaj wōt “rikarejar ro ejej tokjār.”¹² Jejjab maroñ kōlläik iał in ad ñan lañ; jutak ikōtaad im ekajet ej jutak āinwōt juon menin bōbrae, eo ejelōk ad maroñ ie ñan anjō jāne kōn kōj make.

Ak aolep rej jab jako.

Tiriamq an Anij ej kōjatdikdik eo ad elap im ejelōk jemłokin.

Jān katok eo an Jisōs Kraist, karōk in tiriamq eo eñamejlan kajitōk ko an ekajet¹³ “im [bōktok] wāween ko ñan armej bwe ren maroñ tōmak ñan ukwēłok.”¹⁴

Jerawiwi ko ad, meñē bōd ko ami rej āinwōt būrōrō, renabaj mouj āinwōt sno.¹⁵ Kōnke ad Rilomqor ejitōn bōro “ekar lełok E bwe En pinmuur ñan armej otemjej,”¹⁶ juon kōjem̄ ñan aelōñ eo An ejelōk jemłokin kar kōpooje ñan kōj.¹⁷

Kōjem eo ejjab ḥak!

Ak tiriamqo eo an Anij ejjab wōt kōjeplaaktok ñan kōj jikin eo mōkta emmān. Elaññe lōmōqor ej meļelein wōt jerełok bōd ko ad im jerawiwi ko, innām lōmōqor—emmān āinwōt ej—kakūrmool wōt kōttōbar eo elāp an Jemād ñan kōj. Jibadbad eo an eutiejlōk: E ekōnaan bwe ḥaddik im leddik ro nejin ren erom āinwōt E.

Kōn menin letok in tiriamqo an Anij, iał in rikāloor ejjab tōlliklōk kōj; ej tōl lōnlōk kōj.

Ej tōl ñan utiej ko jemaroñ meļeļe joñan utiej ko aer! Ej tōllōk ñan jikin eo ilōntata ilo aiboojoj in al ippān Jemedwōj Ilañ, ijo jej, kabooł kōn ro rejtōn bōrō, bōk tarlep in aiboojoj eo An.¹⁸ Men otemjej rej ad, im kōj rej an Kraist.¹⁹ Emool, men otemjej ko an Jemād renaaj itok ñan kōj.²⁰

Ñan deļoñe aiboojoj in, ej aikuji elāplōk jān kōjem eo eppelļōk, ej aikuji deļoñe kōjem in kōn bōrō eikdeleel ñan oktag—juon oktag elemōñōñō eo jeje ko rej kōmeļeiki āinwōt emōj “bar ḥotak; aaet, ḥotak jān Anij, oktag jān jekjek in [ad ilāl in] im wōtlōk eo aer, ñan jekjek eo ejimwe, im lōmōren jān Anij, im erom māan im kōrā ro nejin.”²¹

Ruo: Tiriamqo ej Kōppelōk Wintō ko Ilañ

Bar juon wāween an Anij tiriamqo ej kōppelōk wintō ko Ilañ, jān ijo Anij ej lutōktok kōjeram̄man ko kōn kajoor im maroñ, komaroñ kōj ñan bōk men ko renaaj kar pen ñan ad tōpari. Ej wałłok jān tiriamqo eo ekabwilōnlōn an Anij bwe ajri ro Nejin ren maroñ anjō ioon kauwōtata ko im kapo ko rettiñqo an rimōq eo, anjō jān jerawiwi, im “rej wāppen [ilo] Kraist.”²²

Meñe kōj aolep ewōr ad mōjñō ko, jemaroñ in anjō jāni. Ilo mōol, menin ej jān tiriamqo an Anij bwe, ñe jej kōttāik kōj make im wōr ad tōmak, mōjñō ko ad rej erom kajoor.²³

Ilo aolepān mour ko ad, tiriamqo, an Anij ej letok ioon kōjeram̄man ko an ānbwin im menin letok ko an jetōb ko rej kōlaplōk maroñ ko ad im kōjeram̄man mour ko ad. Tiriamqo eo An ej kōkōmanmanlōk kōj. An tiriamqo ej jipañ kōj erom ro rem̄mantata.

Wōn Emaroñ Ekkar?

Ilo Baibōl, ej riit kōn lołok eo an Kraist ñan mōweo imōn Saimon Riparissee eo.

Āinwōt, Saimōn juon emmaan emmān im mōol. Ej aolep iien etale laajrak in jerbal ko an im eddo ko an kabuñ: ekar kōjparok kien ko, kōllā juon mōttan joñoul, kōjparok raan in Jabōt, jar aolep raan, im etal ñan jikin kweilōk.

Ak ke Jisōs ekar pād ippān Saimōn, juon kōrā ekar kepaak lōk, kwał neen Rilōmōqor kōn dān in kōmjalalał in mejān im kapit Neen kōn oil.

Saimōn ekar jab mōññōñō kōn wāween kabuñ jar in, kōnke ekar jelā bwe kōrā eo ekar juon rijerawiwi. Saimōn ekar lōmñak ñe Jisōs ekar jab jelā menin, E jab aikuj in juon rikanaan ak E ej jāmin kar kōtłok an kōrā eo uñūri.

Kōlmenļokjeñ kōn lōmñak ko an, Jisōs ekar oktag ñan Saimōn im kajjítōk juon kajjítōk. “Ruo ri mōri an juon ri kamuriri: . . . juon ej mōri kōn limabukwi sillin̄, . . . eo juon kōn lemñoul.

“Im ke ejjeļok ippāerro bwe ren kōllā, ear jeorłok airro mōri. Kōn men in, kwōn ba ñan Eō, wōn iaerro elāp an yokwe e?”

Saimōn e uwaak im ba eo elāp an jeorłok an mōri.

Innām Jisōs ekar katakin juon katak emmān: “Kwōj lo kōrā in ke? . . . Jerawiwi ko an, rellōñ, emōj julōk; bwe elāp an yokwe: a ñan eo e dik an jako, e dik an yokwe.”²⁴

Wōn iaan armej rein ruo rej lukkuun āinwōt?

Je ke āinwōt Saimōn? Jej ke lōke kōj make im aenōm̄man ilo kōmānan man ko ad, lōke ilo ad make wāppen? Jej ke jaje kōmaanwa ippān ro rej jab mour kōn joñak ko ad? Jej ke kōtłok an mōwil ko mōwilid tōl mākūtkūt ko ad, kōm̄mane juon men ilo ad jab lōmñak, etal ñan kweilōk ko ad, pād ilo kūlaaj ko meñe rejelmo, im emool lale cell phone ko ad ilo iien kwojkwoj?

Ak jej ke āinwōt kōrā in, eo ekar lōmñak ejjeļok an kōjatdikdik kōnke jerawiwi ko an?

Elāp ke ad iakwe?

Ñe ej bukwelōlō ñan jar, ej ke ñan kakeememej men eo emmāntata jekar kōm̄mane, ak ej ke ñan kwałok kōn bōrō bōd ko ad, akweļap kōn tiriamqo an Anij, im kōtōrōqolok dān in kōmjalaał kōn kam̄moolol kōn karōk in ekabwilōnlōn kōn pinmuur eo?²⁵

Lōmōqor ej jab maroñ wiaiki kōn mani in pokake; ej pojak ñan kōj kōnke bōtōktōk in Nejin Anij.²⁶ Lōmñak bwe jemaroñ in jāniji jerbal ko ad rem̄man ñan bōk lōmōqor ej āinwōt wiaki juon tiket in baļuun innām lōmñak bwe waad baļuun eo. Ak lōmñak bwe ālkin ad reen e mōweo imōd, kiiō ej jej kabwijer juon taitōl ilo aolepān lał in.

Innām Etke Jej Pokake?

Elaññe tiriamqo ej menin letok an Anij, innām etke elukkuun aorōk pokake kien ko an Anij? Etke ejelļok ñan kien ko an Anij—ak ukwelęłok, kōn unin? Etke jejjab kwałok ke jejerawiwi im kōtłok bwe Anij en lōmōren kōj?

Ak, ñan likūt kajjítōk eo ilo naan ko an Paul, “Jen pād ilo jerowiwi ke, bwe jouj en orłok?” Uwaak eo an Paul epidodo im alikkar: “Anij ej kōtłok.”²⁷

Ro jeiū im jatū, ej ke pokake kien ko an Anij—kōnke ad iakwe ñan E!

Kajjicoñ meļeļe menin letok an Anij ej tiriamqo kōn aolepān būruwōd im lōmñak ej letok ñan kōj aolep im elōñ un ko ñan iakwe im pokake Jemedwōj Ilañ kōn meanwōr im kam̄moolol. Ilo ad etetal ilo iał in rikāloor, ej kōkōmanmanlōk kōj, ej ejaaķe kōj, ej jipañ kōj erom āinwōt E, im ej tōllōk kōj ñan imaan Mejān. “Jetōb eo an Irooj [ad Anij]” ej bōktok “juon oktag ekajoor ilo kōj, . . . bwe rej jab bar itok wōt in kōm̄man nana, ak ñan kōm̄man emmān wōt.”²⁸

Kōn menin, ad pokake kien ko an Anij ej itok āinwōt wałłok in ad iakwe im kam̄moolol ejjeļok jemļokier kōn emmān eo an Anij. Wāween iakwe in emmān im kam̄moolol in enaaj

tuwe ta eo jej kōm̄māne kōn tiriamq̄ an Anij. Wānōk enaj aolep iien pād ilo lōm̄nak ko ad, im ad lōke enaj kajoorlōk imjaan mejān Anij.²⁹

Ro jeiū im jatū, mour tiljek kōn gospel eo ej jab juon men jej eddodo kake. Ej juon kamminene elemō-ñōñō—juon kōbpopo ñān delq̄nē aiboojoj eo elāp an indeeo im indeeo. Jej pukōt ñān pokake Jemedwōj Ilañ kōnke jetōb ko ad renaaj lāplōk aer jelā kōn men ko an jetōb. Jenaaj melele men otemjej jekar jab lōm̄naki mōkta. Meramlōk im melele rej itok ñān kōj ñe jej kōm̄anmān ankilaan Jemād.³⁰

Tiriamq̄ ej menin letok an Anij, im ad kōnqān in pokake ñān kajjojo kien ko an Anij ej ilo ad lelōk pā kein peid rewabanban bwe jen maroñ bōk menin letok kein rekwojarjar jān Jemedwōj Ilañ.

Men Eo Wōt Jemaroñ Kōm̄māne

Rikanaan Nipai ekar kōm̄māne juon jipañ eaorōk ñān ad melele kōn tiriamq̄ an Anij ke ekar kwalōk, “Kimij niknik jerbal . . . ñān kareel buruōn ro nejim, im barāinwōt ro jeim̄ im jatūm̄, ñān tōmak ilo Kraist, im jeplaaktok ñān Anij; bwe kōm̄ jelā bwe ej *jān jouj jej mour, ālkin aolep ijo jemaroñ kōm̄māne make.*”³¹

Kōn menin, ij lōm̄nak ñe jet iien ej bōd ad ukōt naan kein “ālkin joñān wōt ad maroñ kōm̄māne.” Jej aikuj melele bwe “ālkin” ejjab juon wōt aero melele wōt “kōnke.”

Jej jab maroñ bōk lōm̄q̄or “kōnke” aolep men ko jemaroñ kōm̄māne.

Kōj aolep jekar ke kōm̄māne joñān wōt ad maroñ *aolep* men ko jemaroñ kōm̄māni? Anij ekar ke kōttar mae iien jekar kōlaplōk kijejetō ko ad mōkta jān An naaj bōk kōnqān eo ilo mour ko ad kōn tiriamq̄ in lōm̄q̄or eo An?

Elōñ armej rej ebbweer kōnke er rej likjab. Er rejelā jān imminene bwe “An ekōnqān, a kanniōk e mōjñō.”³² Rej lelōñlōk ainikier ippān Nipai ilo kwalōk, “Aō ej liejloj kōn nana ko aō.”³³

Ijejā Nipai ekar jelā tiriamq̄ eo an Rilōm̄q̄or eo ej *kōtlōk im kōmaroñ* kōj ñān anjō ioon jerawiwī.³⁴ Eñin ej unin an Nipai kar lukkuun tiljek ilo jerbal ñān kareel ajri ro nejin ro jein im jatin “ñān tōmak ilo Kraist, im ñān jeplaaktok ñān Anij.”³⁵
