FOR YOUR FAMILY

- What can you do to honor and elevate priesthood leadership in your home?
- What can wives and mothers do to help provide spiritual leadership in their homes? What spiritual gifts have they been given to help them fulfill this responsibility?
- How do all the members of your family work together to make your home “a house of God”?
- What does it mean to build a family’s foundation upon “the rock of our Redeemer”? (Helaman 5:12). How can you do this in your family?

FOR YOUR CALLING

- What does it mean to bring up children “in light and truth”? What can you do in your calling to support parents in this responsibility?
- What can you do to help mothers and fathers in your ward or stake become spiritual leaders in their homes?
