- What does it mean to minister?
- What examples from the scriptures can you think of in which the Savior ministered to others?
- How has your family been blessed by priesthood leaders ministering?
- What opportunities does your family have to minister to others?

FOR YOUR CALLING

- What principles do you learn from Elder Christensen and Elder Clayton that can help you be more effective at ministering?
- What experiences have taught you the power of priesthood ministering?
- Elder Clayton refers to the Lord's promise in Doctrine and Covenants 84:88. How have you seen the promise fulfilled in your efforts to minister to others?
- Whom do you know who could benefit from this type of ministering?
- What can you do to help them feel the Savior's love?
